TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All Entrants must be members of the GKBA and USBC certified.
2. USBC current rules will be observed. Any tournament rules not covered in this form shall be covered by USBC tournament rules. The Tournament director will rule on any rules not covered by these rules or USBC.
3. All Bowlers will use their highest GKBA yearbook average from the 2024-2025 season of at least 21 games. If a bowler does not have a 2024-2025 yearbook average, they will be required to provide proof of their average via a standing sheet prior to bowling. If unable to provide a standing sheet the bowler will bowl scratch with a 230 average. Rule 319a (10 pins over) is in effect for ALL averages prior to bowling.
4. Reporting of incorrect averages (USBC Rule 319a) - Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to competition shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average. If submitted average is higher than correct average, prize winnings will be based on submitted averages.
5. USBC Rule 319e may be enforced. The Tournament director reserves the right to re-rate a bowler.
6. Starting lanes will be determined by the Tournament director.
7. Foul language or obscene gestures will not be allowed.
8. One lane courtesy will be observed.
9. Scoring errors MUST be reported immediately. If a score must be corrected, stop bowling and contact a tournament official.
10. Tardy bowlers will be scored 0 for every frame missed.
11. If a player must leave due to emergency or injury, that bowler will be scored with their absentee score. The withdrawal must be approved by the Tournament director.
12. The surface of the bowling ball(s) can only be altered before competition begins. No ball can be adjusted once competition begins (per USBC tournament rules)
13. Once competition begins, the ball can only be wiped and/or cleaned with a dry towel or shammy. If the ball is returned with a foreign substance on it (i.e., grease or belt marks etc.), the tournament director must approve requests to clean the ball with ANY kind of cleaner.
14. No foreign substance of any kind is permitted on bowlers shoes. This includes but is not limited to powder, ashes and EZ slide.
15. All bowling balls must be USBC approved and no bowling balls may be used prior to release date to the general public. This will result in disqualification.
16. The tournament handicap divisions will be 90% from a 230 base. Handicaps for each event will be calculated per bowler and totaled for each team.
 - a. Open division teams will consist of 5 bowlers.
 - b. Women's division teams will consist of 4 bowlers
 - c. Senior open division teams will consist of 4 bowlers. **Must be at least 55 years old in order to bowl in the Senior division.**
17. Bowlers may enter TEAM event 2 times with changing out 2 bowlers in each division. Bowlers may enter DOUBLES and SINGLES 2 times with changing your doubles partner. Your score from your first Team, Doubles and Singles will be the score that is used for All Events.
18. **All Events scores have to come from the same division (i.e. seniors, open or women's). Can not use scores from open division and senior division.**
19. Substitutions must be made no less than 30 minutes before bowling time. Multiple entry substitutions must be approved by tournament management or risk disqualification.
20. USBC rule 319D will not apply. No tournament prize winnings need be reported.
